On behalf of the Harrington Family Foundation (HFF), I am pleased to share with you that we have moved on from hard copy applications, and launched our online application tool for the *Oregon Community Quarterback Scholarship* 2017/2018 academic year!

**Enclosed in this mailing is a flyer about the scholarship. Please feel free to share with faculty and staff, and circulate as needed.**

Established in 2014 by Oregon native Joey Harrington, HFF Founder and former NFL quarterback, the four-year renewable scholarship is awarded every year to four Oregon high school students who demonstrate an aptitude for leadership and plan to attend an Oregon university, college or trade school, but may need financial assistance getting there. Four scholarships will be issued for the 2017/2018 academic year. Each scholarship is worth \$2,500 per year for a total commitment of \$10,000 per student.

To be considered, all applicants must submit a completed application online, which includes a one-page personal essay and two letters of recommendation. The application deadline for the 2017/2018 academic year is **March 31, 2017**. Scholarship recipients will be notified by May 1, 2017. Apply here: <http://harringtonfamilyfoundation.slideroom.com>
